

Volunteers needed for the John Rogers Art Docent Program!



What is the Art Docent Program?

The Art Docent program involves a volunteer “Art Docent” visiting a class virtually once a month to present a piece of art, lead a discussion, and complete an art project with the students. For the ‘20-’21 school year, the program will serve grades K-5, and will be part of remote learning.

Who can be an Art Docent?

Everyone is invited to participate and you do not need an art degree! Ideally we are looking for at least two parents or guardians per classroom. Orientation/training will be provided.

What is my time commitment?

The Art Docent program generally runs from October/November through May, with one lesson being taught each month. The day and time of each lesson/presentation will be determined by the docent and classroom teacher, and may be synchronous or asynchronous. As this is the first year that we are taking the program online, some additional planning meetings with all the docents will likely be required.
